

HERDSPERSON POSITION



The Hoard's Dairyman Farm, a 120-year-old dairy farm, is seeking a candidate to fill a **full-time herds person** position. The farm is located in Fort Atkinson, Wisconsin, and home to the nation's oldest registered Guernsey herd. The herd ranks near the top of the breed genetically and markets live cattle and embryos worldwide. The 300-cow herd is milked and cared for in a newly constructed robotic milking facility and work is underway to move calf care indoors to automatic calf feeders.

The herds person's responsibilities include, but are not limited to, oversight of milking herd health and ensure compliance of herd care protocols, fresh cow monitoring, newborn calf care, and data analysis from milking and calf care software. The individual also will help provide a practical and positive experience to the farm's nearly 3,000 yearly visitors. Artificial insemination, oral and IV fluid administration, skid loader operation, and basic knowledge of herd management software is helpful, but not required. Willing to train someone eager to learn.

Compensation includes housing, paid utilities, competitive salary, regular time off, paid vacation, company match 401k, uniforms, health, dental, and vision insurance.
